

## Report: Intra-College Mehndi Competition

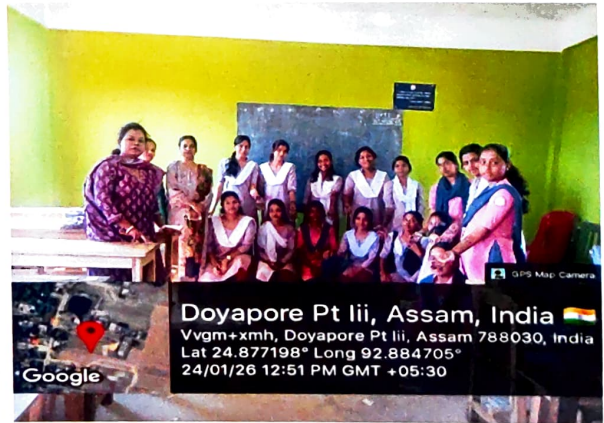


