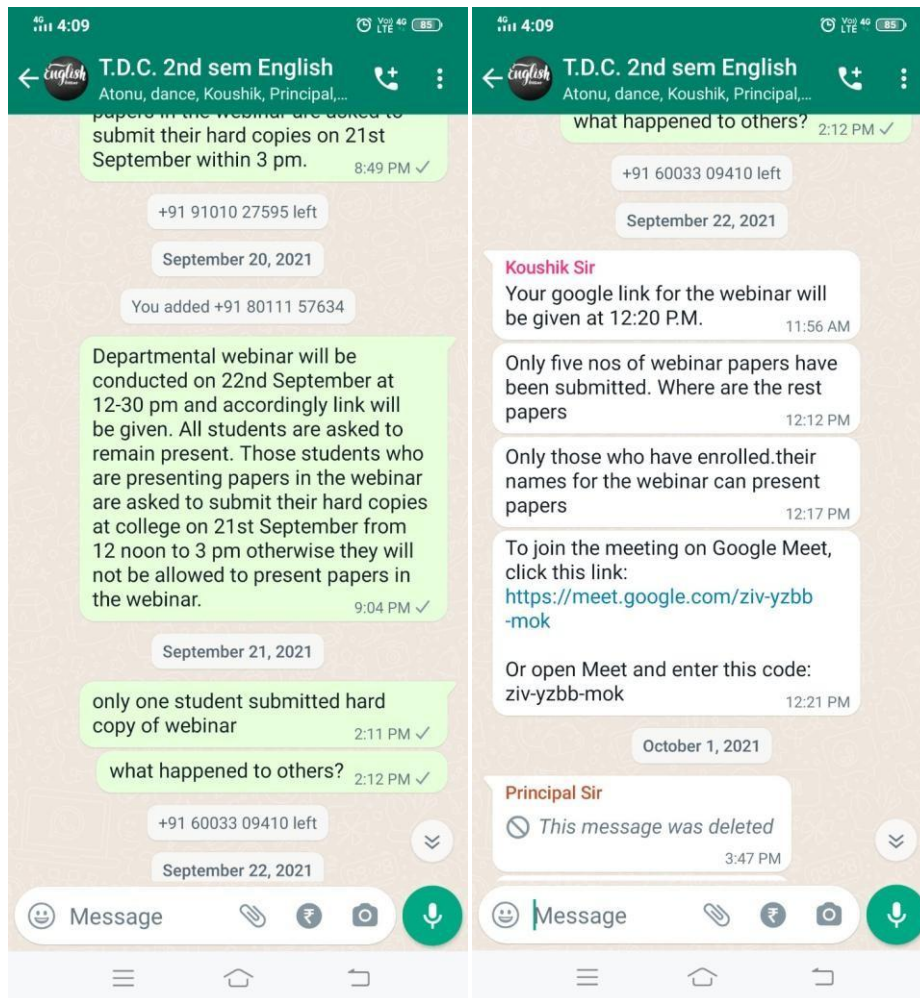
## Report of the Department Webinar:

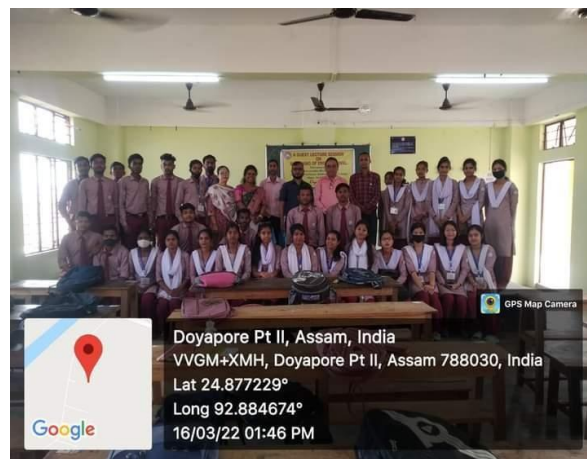


## A Report on Invited Talk/ Guest Lecture Session
