

All the students and teachers were present in the occasion and participate actively in the Programme. The Pricl- was Sir Bikram Chakraborty.

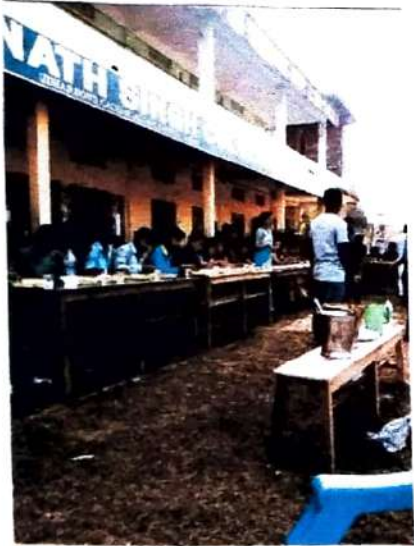
Students of different schools and junior colleges visited in this occasion and Mahaprasad distributed to them. More than three hundred people were present in this occasion.

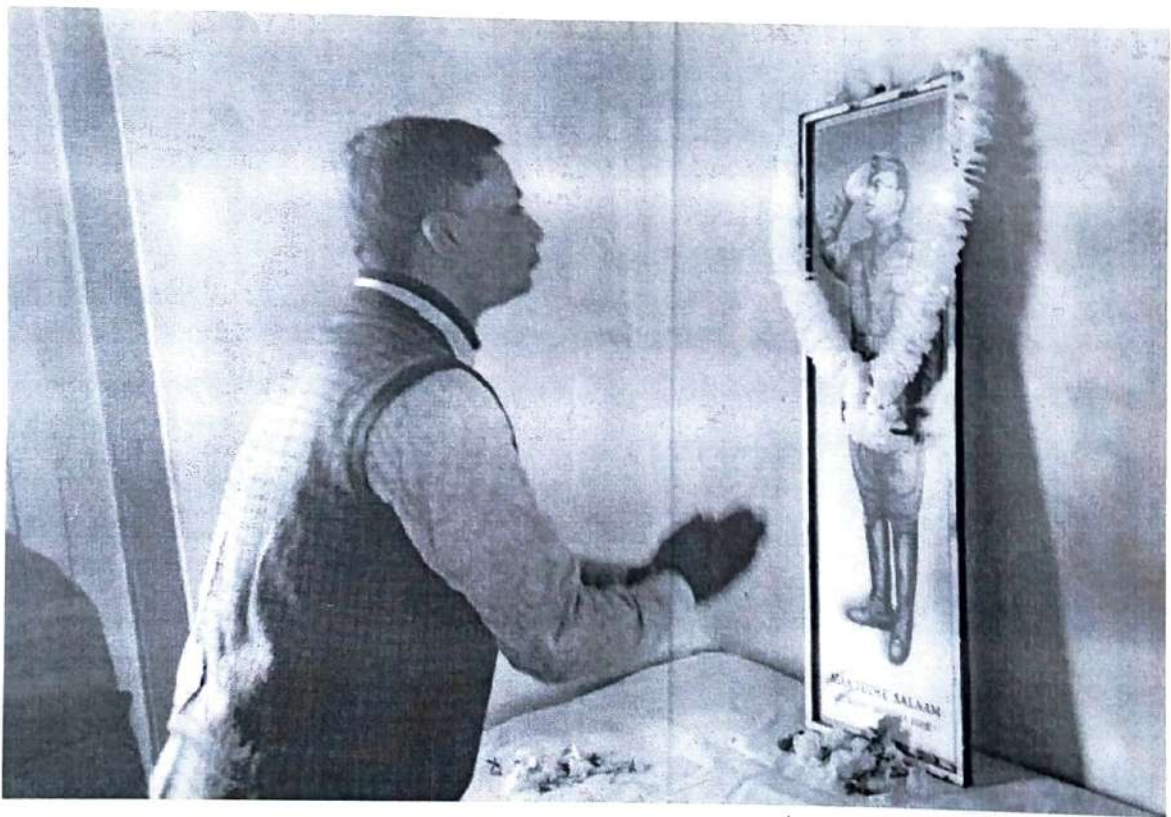

Details of the activity

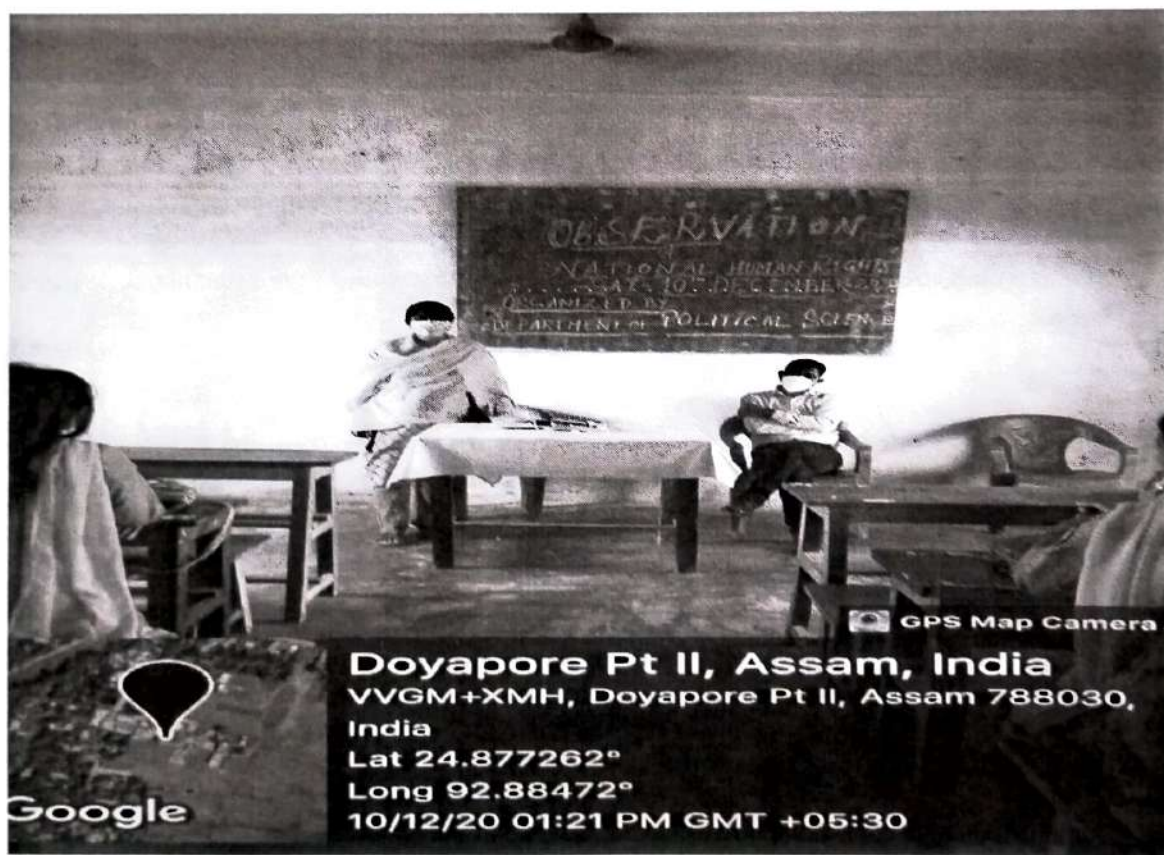
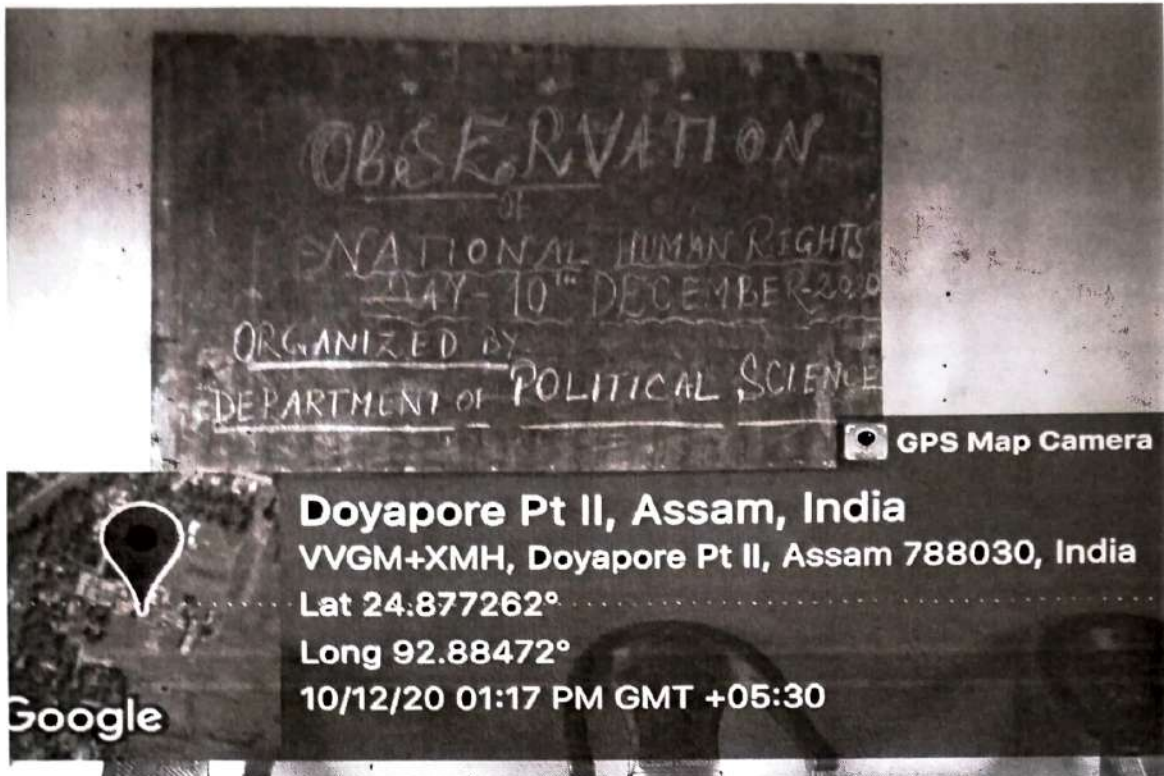

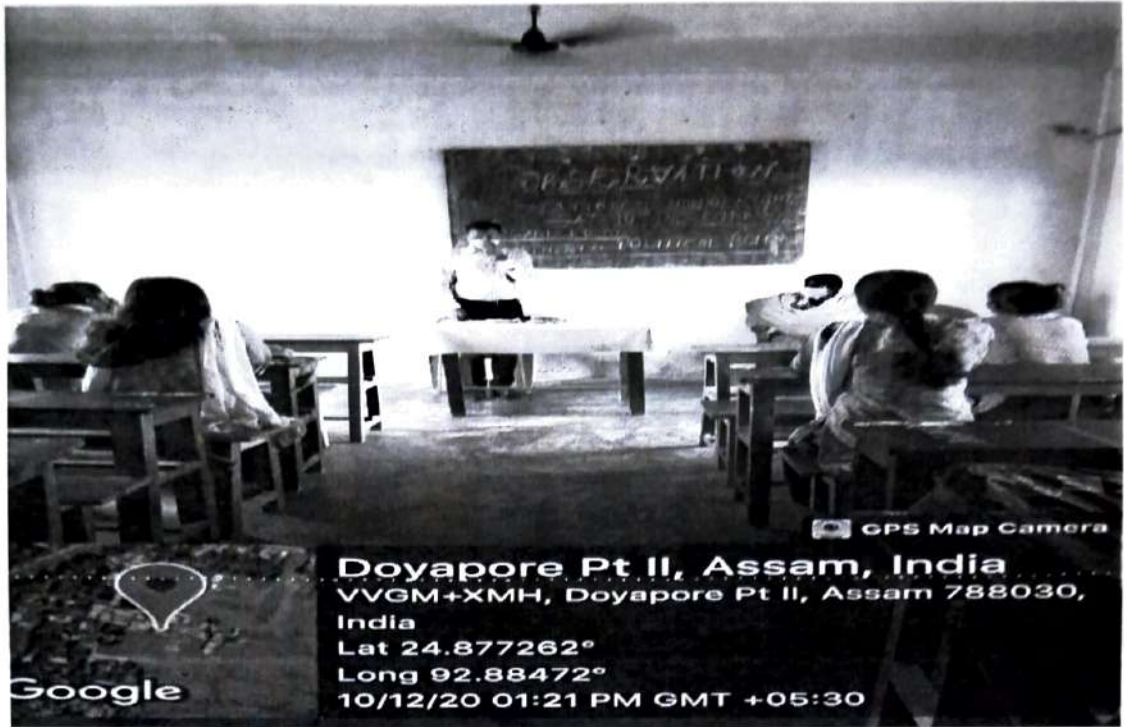

Details of the Programme

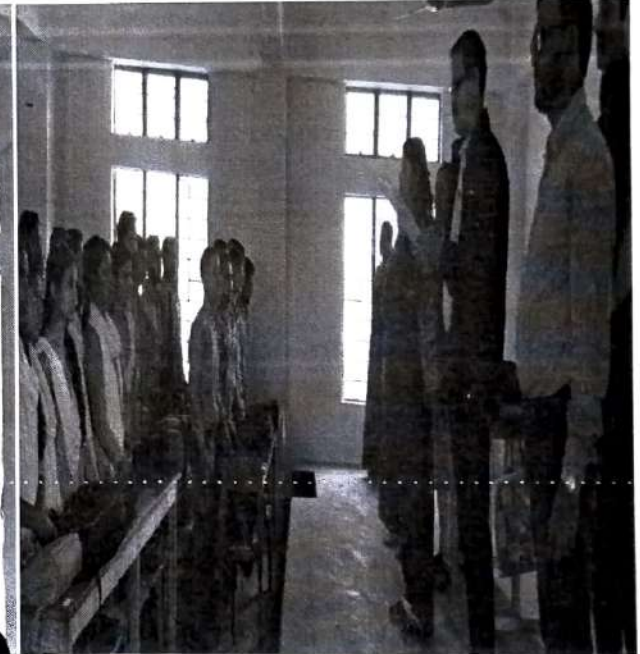
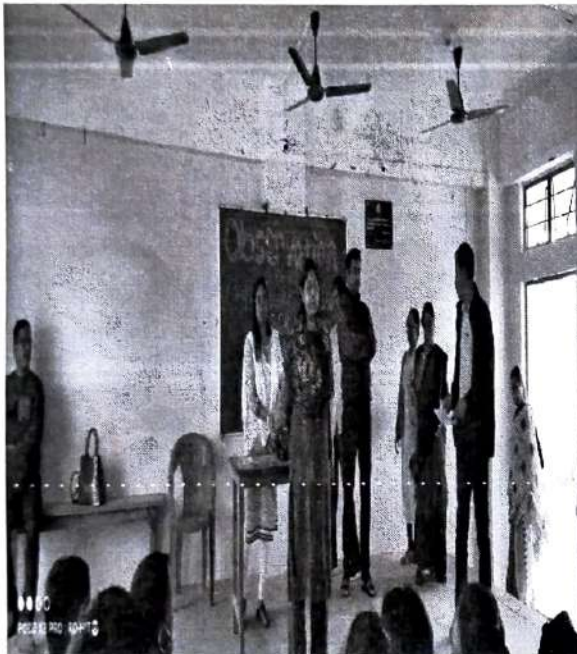
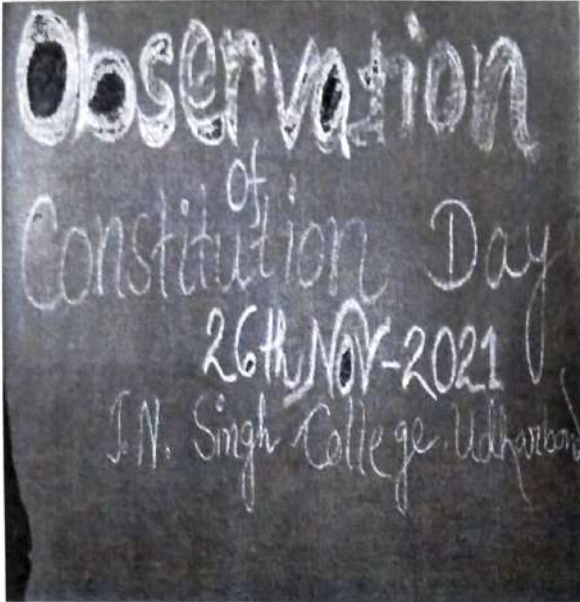

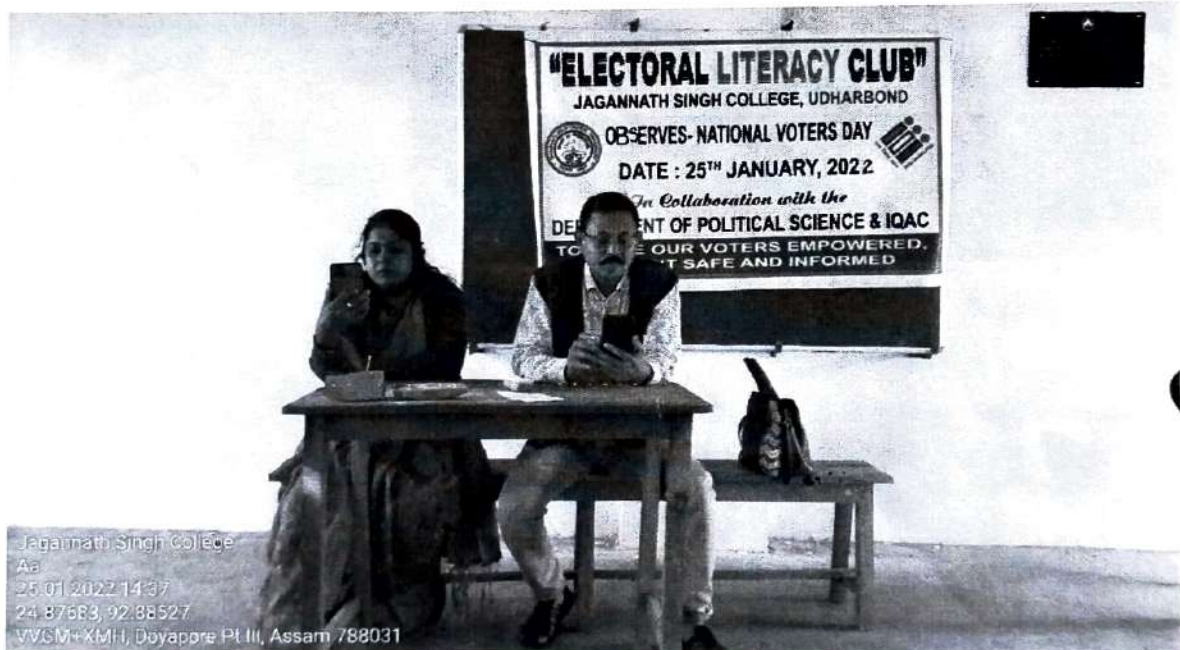
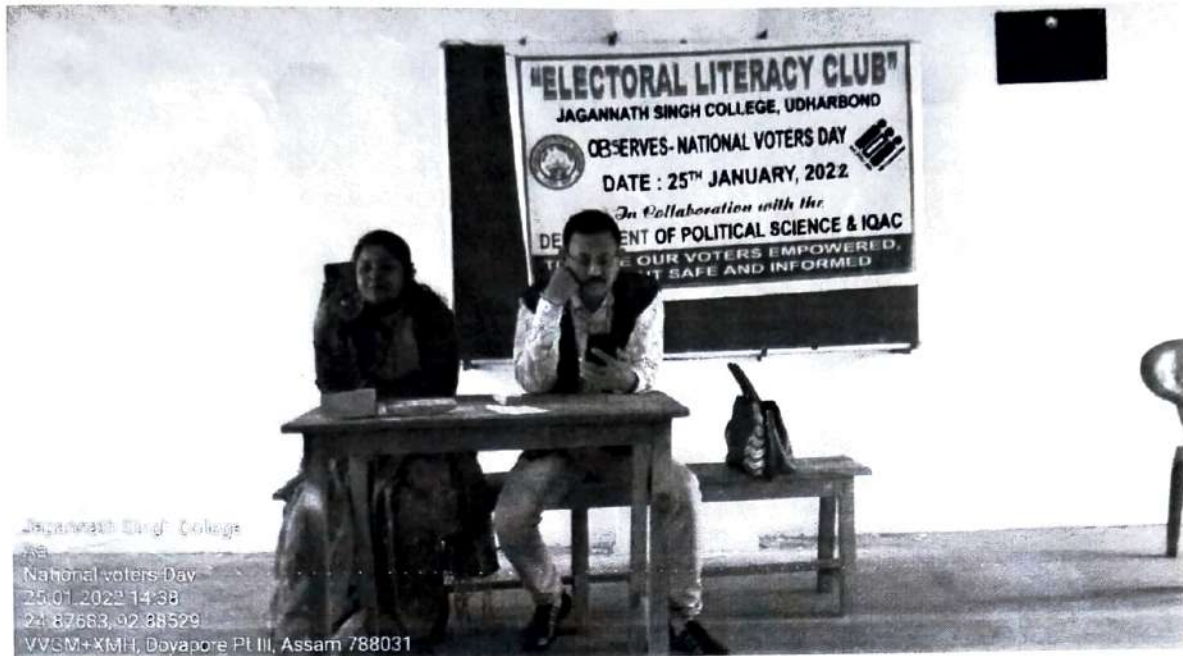
The programme was concluded with oath taking of the pledge for National Voters Day, 25th January, 2022 and it was administered by Dr. Swapan Das of the same Department.
